Meeting Minutes March 4, 2021 4:00 pm

1. The PTK took a few moments to make a video with the goal of lifting spirits through expressions of gratitude, pride, and appreciation of each and every student within the CGE school community. The third quarter is done. Only one more to go. Keep your eyes and ears open because this public service announcement is coming to a Chromebook near you!

# 2. School News

- Ms. Pietrocci addressed the press release from the day. Santa Fe Public Schools and the National Education Association are in agreement, through a Memorandum of Understanding, that teachers and staff will be required to return to work in-person once vaccinated or have had the chance to be vaccinated. It's not a requirement to be vaccinated, what is required is to return to in-person education as soon as possible. Those who have an exemption from human resources may continue to work remotely. Everyone else is expected to return to campus.
- Parents and guardians are being asked to choose if their student(s) will participate in standardized testing for grades three and up. They may opt in, and more information will become available regarding the logistics of testing. Ms. Pietrocci mentioned so much is still being ironed out to ensure everyone is Covid safe. Members of the PTK asked what the benefit was to opt in for testing and what value was it to the school. Ms. Pietrocci explained this option, to test or not, is new and really offers no valuable data points to the schools, teachers, or even the students because the data is already so skewed for a few reasons. Without ensuring everyone is tested and tested on the same test it is impossible to really make a valuable comparison and understand how to address the high and low points. She mentioned last year the State waived the requirement for this test (PARCC) and this year it is a different test (i.e. different questions). Without complete participation and consistent participation with a consistent measurement, the results do not offer valuable information for the schools.
- Big thank you's to Ms. Frances and Ms. Kate for all the fun events with Read Across America. Ms. Frances commented that so far, all is going well, and it has been fun seeing the kids dress up as their favorite characters. Lots of positive feedback from the Kindergartners were paired with older readers. She still seeks volunteers for Mystery readers for the second-grade group. Ms. Kate volunteered to be one and both Ms. Pietrocci and Mr. John may be invited to participate too. Mr. Winterstein's class was so excited. It was heartwarming to see the students rise to the challenge and how well their hard work was received.

• Book log contests (think March Madness) will be outlined in an upcoming e-blast. It is a school wide voluntary program and will launch right after spring break. Kate will send out more information for daily activities and an estimate for ordering prizes.

#### 3. Yearbook
