3. School News

- a. - c. Cory Brown will be displaced to another school as all teachers are returning
- d. NDI will still be paid for by district
- e. Request for \$8000 for before/after school teacher pay
- f. Ms. Kate – Literacy Family 16 of May Friday before last week of school – taking book donations Public library will be there going over summer reading – give away free books and have a big summer reading bash Kate is reaching out to a few more people
 - Steve will reach out to Mathnasium about coming
 - Spread the word we need good condition gently used – we have a lot of younger kid so looking for more chapter books etc
